



Indonesian Histories, Oral Traditions, and Archives

Professor Laurie Sears, University of Washington

This course explores themes in the construction of Indonesian histories and stories. The focus is on oral traditions and testimonies, written testimonies and unconventional archives in the production of Indonesian histories. We will investigate how oral and written testimonies become part of historical archives. We will also explore some of the theoretical work on oral tradition, archival constructions, and literary and performance traditions as they relate to nationalism and Islam in Indonesia. The course covers major scholarship in English on testimonies, archives and surrounding issues of Indonesian historiography. It also shows how literary works can be used as historical sources.
